Volunteer Code of Conduct

All volunteers involved in supporting BEAF should endeavour to follow this Code of Conduct and inform **the Management Committee** in the event of becoming aware of or suspecting a breach of this Code of Conduct.

All volunteers should:

- Behave professionally at all times and present a positive attitude - you will be seen others as a representative of the BEAF organisation.
- Attend volunteer meetings and inductions, or speak to the volunteer Coordinator and arrange an agreement if you cannot attend one.
- Only sign up to volunteer shifts that you can attend.
- Treat everyone with respect and dignity regardless of gender, ethnicity, disability, sexuality or beliefs: this includes co-volunteers, staff, and audience members and the public.
- Not have any inappropriate physical or verbal contact with others.
- Not to perform duties under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- To wear suitable but casual clothing for events and workshops.
- Endeavour to follow all BEAF policies and procedures that apply to you.
- Not engage in criminal or illegal activity whilst volunteering for BEAF, this includes the possession of Dangerous Weapons or Firearms.
